GV-HEAT administers four high-quality home energy efficiency and weatherization solutions for homes and incomes of any size.

Income-Qualified Programs:

- Colorado Affordable Residential Energy (CARE) program: Offers free energy assessments and home repairs for income-qualified households.
- Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP): Offers free weatherization services for income-qualified households.
- USDA Rural Housing Service Programs: Offers free weatherization and home improvement services to available income-qualified owner-occupied households where one household member is 62 or older

Non-Income Qualified Program:

- Energy Smart Colorado (ESC) Program: Offers discounted home energy assessments

Visit the program website to register. A member of GV-HEAT will contact you to schedule your home's assessment and improvements. We will work with you throughout the process to ensure that your home receives the attention and care it deserves.
